Objectives



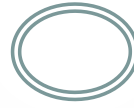
- To increase young people's skills through the practical experience of volunteering abroad;

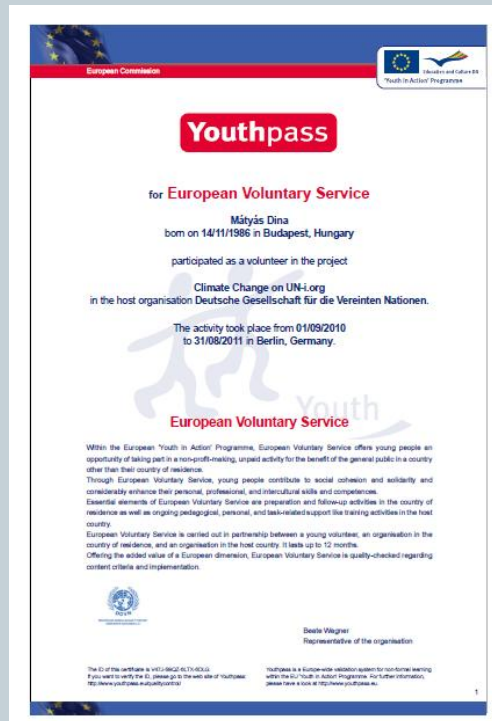
Other Expenses
